AT HOME

Training & Care	Our program is designed to accommodate each individual. The program will give your horse a consistent workout schedule that adds to the health and condition of your horse. Schooling sessions and lessons will be arranged by our staff to accommodate horse and rider needs. Lessons will be available Tuesdays through Sundays at times that best fit the client's schedule. Services that are included in the training program are: daily maintenance, schooling, lessons, tum-out, tacking up and un-tacking the horse after each ride, blanketing, veterinary treatments and the scheduling of all horse shows, shoeing, veterinary care and any other needs of the individual horse. Does-not include body clipping (To be done-at trainer's discretion).	\$1,450.00

Supplements & Extra Feed	Scheduled by our staff to aid in the condition and health of your horse.	Varies, Billed at Cost
Medication	Barn veterinarian (Dr. Josh Hall) may be consulted. Prescribed and administered depending on the needs of the individual horse.	Varies, Billed at Cost
Laundry	Includes laundering of all barn supplies, towels, polo's, pads used in the everyday training and care of your horse. Does not include show equipment, blankets or sheets.	\$25.00
Barn Supplies	Includes all supplies used in the everyday care, training and maintenance of your horse.	Varies, Billed at Cost
Customers Not In Training	Lessons - Group or Private Training Rides	\$150.00 \$100.00

SALES & PURCHASES

Trainer Per Diem	Fifty Percent (50%) of total per diem will be credited to commission at the close of sale or purchase. This per diem applied when trainer is required to travel in the pursuit of sale or purchase of horse. This per diem is not applicable when trainer and/or client try horses at shows at which they are competing.	\$100.00 Per Day
Travel Cost	Client is responsible for payment of travel costs.	
Commission	On all sales, purchases or lease price	15%

HORSE SHOWS

Deposits are required in advance for all shows - \$500.00 per horse per show-No Exceptions. Deposits will be applied to itemized monthly show billing. Please calculate your deposit and send wit/r your monthly payment.

Show Day Fees	Provided for all horses participating at any horse show, billed per horse. Fees begin upon departure from the barn. At a multi day show, partial fee will be charged at trainers discretion depending on amount of training

Grooming	Paid to Groom Directly	\$50.00 plus tip
Laundry and Supplies	Vary from show to show, include purchases made at show for grooming supplies and any laundry associated with a show and show supplies. Along with the annual expenses pertaining to curtain and tack room maintenance.	Divided by Number of Horses
Other Show Related Expenses	Show feed, bedding, tack stall and security	Divided by Number of Horses
Trainer Expense	Daily per diem for each trainer, travel expenses, rentals, and accommodations. l	Divided by Number of Horses
Pharmacy	Prescribed and administered depending on the needs of the individual horse. Rates vary depending on type and quantity of medication.	Billed at Cost

Entries	Filled out and sent by Willow Brook staff prior to closing date of show entries. Classes are chosen by the trainer to insure the best results for horse and rider.	Your open check at the show office, please close out by Sunday AM.
Shipping Transportation	Willow Brook staff will make arrangements. Rates will vary depending on location and company used. It is requested that this fee be paid directly to the company no later than Saturday afternoon.	Your check to the vendor providing service.
Braiding	Arranged by Willow Brook staff for all hunters and equitation horses depending on show. Trainer's discretion shall apply to braiding tails. It is requested that this fee be paid directly to the vendor no later than Saturday afternoon.	Your check to the vendor providing service.

Grooming, Feed & bedding, Shipping and Braiding Services will have itemized bills and envelopes for payment tacked up inside of the tack room at all shows. For above fees and show office a total of five checks will be needed at all shows.

WILLOW BROOK STABLES requests that you stay current with your payments to WILLOW BROOK STABLES, Flintridge Riding Center, Veterinarians, Haulers, and Blacksmiths and all other vendors as these are required essentials for your horse.

Willow Brook Stables requests that you stay current and up to date on all association memberships and horse registrations. The following associations require memberships: USA Equestrian, PCHA, LAHSA, ASPCA, USET, CPHA and AHJF. Willow Brook staff will assist you in choosing and enrolling in associations.

Late Fees of 11/2% are charged on balances not received 15 days after billing.
